

Papaverine, Phentolamine, and Prostaglandin Injection (Penile Injection)

Medication:

This compounded prescription may contain some or all of the following: Papaverine, Phentolamine, and Prostaglandin (Penile Injection)

Use:

The medications listed above are used in combination for a variety of purposes, one of which may be for the treatment of erectile dysfunctions.

Side Effects:

This medication may cause headache, pain or bruising at the site of injection, upset stomach, drowsiness, flushing, sweating, light-headedness, or prolonged, painful erection (priapism).

Precautions:

Patients should contact their physician if they experience redness, lumps, swelling, tenderness, curving of the erect penis or prolonged painful erections.

Directions:

This medication should be injected into the penis according to the directions provided by the patient's prescriber. Patients should not use this medication if it is cloudy, discolored or contains particles. Patients should always follow their physician's or pharmacist's instructions. Patients should not exceed the dosage prescribed by their physician. This medication should be stored as directed by the pharmacist.
